Oak Hill Boys Ranch is located ½ mile south of the town of Bon Accord (20 min. N of Edmonton).

As a child and youth care worker you will be responsible for a variety of duties including: individual therapy, case management, written & verbal communication, crisis and behavioral management, milieu programming, activity programming, community integration, family support, and Aboriginal programming. Child care positions involve working within a schedule of rotating evenings and day shifts (6 on, 3 off).
