## Roommate Companion Required

McMan Youth, Family and Community Services Association is looking for potential roommate companions for the Transition to Independence Program. This program assists youth aged 16-24 who have Child Intervention status who are transitioning to independent living. This program operates based on Housing First and Harm Reduction philosophies.

A roommate companion living arrangement allows the youth to live semi-independently in shared accommodation with an adult roommate who can provide them with support, skill training, and monitoring based on the youth's unique needs. All youth have a McMan Follow up Support Worker to assist them in achieving their goals.

Successful candidates are expected to welcome and support youth in their own home, act as positive role models and provide informal support and guidance while maintaining their regular lifestyles.

Roommate companions will receive as compensation, a monthly tax-free stipend.

- ❖ **A roommate companion with an extra room within their home to provide support for a *male* youth**

### **Here's what you will need to get an Interview:**

- ❖ Criminal Record Check and Intervention Record issued within last 6 months
- ❖ Current Standard First Aid/CPR – Level C
- ❖ ASIST/Suicide Intervention (*if you don't have ASIST we can make arrangements for you to obtain them once hired*)
