- Supports other agency initiatives as requested.
- Participates in research and other specialized projects, as assigned.

- Masters or Ph.D. Degree in Psychology, Social Work, Family Nursing, or a related field.
- Is currently registered/has membership in the appropriate professional association/with the appropriate regulatory body.
